Sanction for Jain trust land redevpt revoked

Pune: Maharashtra state charity commissioner Anurag Bende on Thursday passed an order revoking April 4, 2025, sanction to redevelop 3.5-acre property owned by Seth Hiranand Nemchand Namkar Trust in Model Colony. The order allowed trustees and Gokhale Landmarks LLP to initiate the cancellation of the sale deed and the power of attorney. Koloti also directed the trust to refund Rs 20 crore to the developer once the sale deed is cancelled.

The deal landed in controversy after the Jain community objected to the trust's decision, leading to two weeks of protests. A hostel and a Jain temple/prayer hall stand on the premises. Following a call by Jain religious leader Acharya Gopinandi Maharaj threatening an indefinite hunger strike from Nov 1 if the agreement was not scrapped, both the trust and developer informed the charity commissioner of their intentions to withdraw from the deal.

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China OKs supply of rare earth magnets to 'some Indian cos'

Nod Comes With Riders: No-Export To US, No-Use For Def Industries

New Delhi: Govt Thursday said "some Indian companies" have got approval from China to import rare earth magnets from the country to be used in the automotive and electronics industries.

MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said licences have been issued to the companies, which will enable them to get access to the magnets whose procurement had been stopped after China put curbs on their sale earlier this year.

The curbs have impacted the production of automobi-

les, especially electric cars and two-wheelers with companies petitioning govt to take up the matter with China.

"Yes, we confirm that some Indian companies have received licences for importing rare earth magnets from China," Jaiswal said while responding to questions on the matter.

"As far as the question of the latest talks and relaxations that have happened between the US and China (and) how it is going to play into our domain, I will come back to you. We have yet to look at it. I am not aware of the technical details. But we will come back to you. But I do confirm that Indian companies have received licences for importing rare earth magnets from China," he said.

Jaiswal, however, did not give details of the companies that have received permission. Industry sources said the companies include those that supply components to the automotive and electronics industries.

However, the imports come with certain restrictions. These include conditions that the magnets cannot be exported to the US, and cannot be used for defence-related industries.

Rare earth magnets are the strongest type of permanent magnets commercially available. Their high magnetic strength and resistance to demagnetisation make them indispensable in a range of applications, especially where weight and space are constraints.

China is estimated to account for about 70% of global rare earth metals mining and holds nearly 90% of the world's rare earth magnet production.

One of the reasons China dominates the rare earth magnet industry is its control over the supply chain, including mining of rare earth ores, separation and refining of rare earth elements, and alloy production and magnet manufacturing. Just in the Indian auto industry alone, about 570 tonnes of rare earth magnets are required to be imported in FY 2025-26 out of the country's estimated overall requirement of 3,600 tonnes.

'Will continue to buy energy from affordable sources'

New Delhi: As the US targets Russia by sanctioning some of its largest oil companies, Indian govt said Thursday it's studying the implications of the sanctions and will consider evolving dynamics of the global market. It also reiterated India will continue to secure affordable energy from diverse sources.

"Without sharing much details about the status of the ongoing negotiations with the US for a trade deal, the govt said India remained engaged with Washington for finalising the agreement. "We are studying the implications of the recent US sanctions on Russian oil companies. Our decisions naturally take into account the evolving dynamics of the global market," said MEA spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal.

"Our position on the larger question of energy sourcing is well known. In this endeavour, we are guided by the imperative to secure affordable energy from diverse sources to meet the energy security needs of our 1.4 billion people," added the official.

The spokesman said India's official Indian response to sanctions that the US imposed on Russian oil companies citing Moscow's "lack of serious commitment to a peace process to end the war in Ukraine". The sanctions targeted Russia's two largest oil companies, Open Joint-Stock Company Rosneft Oil Company (Rosneft) and Public



Joint-Stock Company Oil Company Lukoil (Lukoil). Rosneft has a 49% stake in India's Nayara Energy, which is under sanctions from both the US and the EU.

SC shifts Punjab hit-&-run trial to Delhi court

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Thursday transferred the trial in a hit-and-run case involving the death of a motorcyclist from Phagwara in Punjab to Rohini courts in Delhi after his widow expressed apprehensions over fairness of the trial in state where the accused is a probation judicial officer.

However, the bench acceded to the request from the counsel for the judicial officer to exempt him from personal appearance after he undertook that he would have no objection if the Delhi court recorded the statements of witnesses in the presence of his counsel, who shall mandatorily attend the proceedings on every scheduled date of hearing without fail.

The SC asked the accused to mark his attendance before the Rohini court through video conferencing and told him that under no circumstances should his counsel seek adjournment of trial proceedings.

NHAI simplifies process to complete KYV for FASTags

New Delhi: A day after the TOI report on the problems faced by vehicle owners to complete the Know Your Vehicle (KYV) process for FASTags, National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) on Thursday simplified the process. Under the revised guidelines, FASTag services won't be stopped for non-compliant vehicles and users will get sufficient opportunity to complete the process.

"Under the simplified KYV guidelines, side photographs of car, jeep or van will no longer be required. Only the front picture showing the number plate and FASTag will be required to be uploaded. Also, provisions will be made to automatically fetch RC details from Vahan database," said an official statement issued by the road transport ministry.

It also said that to maintain continuity of services, FASTags issued before the KYV policy (issued on June 20, 2024) will remain active unless complaints are received for loose tags or misuse.

In addition, issuer banks will send SMS reminders to users to complete KYV. It added that in case a user faces difficulty in uploading documents, the issuing bank will contact the customers to assist in completing the process.

Officials said customers can also lodge complaints or raise queries on the NH helpline number 1033 for any issue.

TOI in its report published Wednesday highlighted difficulties faced by vehicle owners in uploading documents for FASTag verification.

After 5 years in jail, woman acquitted of killing 7-yr-old

Mohali: After spending nearly five years in jail, a woman accused of murdering a seven-year-old boy was acquitted by a Mohali court on Thursday, which said the prosecution had failed to establish motive, consistent evidence, or prove murder beyond reasonable doubt.

Amandeep Kaur, a resident of Gharuan village, remained in judicial custody for four years, eight months and 12 days as no one came forward to stand surety for the woman's bail, her counsel C S Bawa said.

"The entire evidence leads this court to an inference that the deceased might have died accidentally. The suspicion, however grave, cannot take the place of cogent proof," the court said, acquitting Amandeep on all charges. The court emphasised adherence to the "Panchsheel principle" of circumstantial evidence, which requires that all circumstances must be fully established and form a complete chain pointing only to the guilt of the accused.

The court said that while the evidence suggested the boy may have drowned in the water drum found in the accused's house, there was nothing to show that the drowning was intentional or that Amandeep was responsible. "The evidence on record proves that on the date of occurrence, the deceased went to the house of the accused and what happened inside that house was never proved by the prosecution. There is no eyewitness in the case, and the circumstantial evidence is insufficient to conclude that Amandeep Kaur caused the boy's death," the court stated.

The prosecution's case was riddled with inconsistencies and missing links, the court found.

Bawa added that 21 witnesses were examined during the trial, but none could corroborate the prosecution's version of events.

Couple serving life term for murder gets parole for IVF after 15 yrs in jail

Ahmedabad: Fifteen years of separation. A shared sense of duty. A Gujarat high court on Thursday granted parole to a couple convicted of murdering the woman's former boyfriend in 2010 — a chance to create life, even while serving time for taking oocyte retrieval. Jayendra Damor and Sejal Baria have been granted extended parole to undergo in-vitro fertilisation (IVF) treatment, marking a rare judicial allowance for imprisoned convicts seeking parenthood. Damor and Baria, both serving life terms in separate prisons for the killing of Pinakin Patel, are out on parole until Nov 2, following the HC order that described their plea as deserving of "sympathetic consideration". The two were convicted by a Godhra district court in 2013 for conspiring to lure Patel — who allegedly continued to harass Baria after their breakup — to a guesthouse, where he was murdered. At the time, Baria was a PTC college student in Rajkot and in a relationship with Damor. Now in their late thirties, the couple told the court they wished to have a child through IVF, for which they required ongoing medical supervision. Baria was first released on remand parole in 2025 for infertility treatment and began consulting a gynaecologist. Based on her medical reports, Damor later sought parole for himself, citing the need to participate in the procedure.

On Oct 16, HC granted Damor temporary release to accompany Baria, who had already been freed by jail authorities for her ongoing treatment. When the couple appeared before the court again on Oct 28, Justice HD Shah agreed to extend the parole period.

"Having regard to the facts and circumstances and for the reasons stated in the application, the same is partly allowed and the parole leave period... is extended up to Nov 2, 2025, on the same terms and conditions," HC said. The bench, however, drew a clear line on leniency: "The applicant shall surrender before the concerned jail authority immediately after the aforesaid period is over. No further extension shall be granted."



They appeared before the court again on Oct 28, Justice HD Shah agreed to extend the parole period.
