Dear Team,

As we bid farewell to one of the most remarkable years for BPCL, I want to express my deepest gratitude for your unwavering dedication and resilience. Once again, true to the spirits of 'BPCians', together we navigated global economic slowdown, crimping demand growth, volatile markets, operational hurdles and emerged stronger as a team.

BPCL recorded the highest ever PAT of Rs 19052 Crore in H1. This was abled by our highest ever half yearly throughput of 19.7 MMT and total sales of 25.6 MMT with highest GRM amongst PSU refineries. Dynamic changes to operating parameters and stringent monitoring practices aided us to process challenging crudes to optimize crude cost, this was one among the major contributors for success reflected above. With this, we've not only secured our own success but also contribute significantly to India's energy security and economic growth.

A remarkable year of Aspirations for BPCL, that accentuated the short term and long term financial and cultural aspirations of our company. Through 'Project Aspire' we shall continue to nurture our core businesses *Refining, Marketing and Upstream*, while making bold bets in *Petrochemicals, Gas, Green Energy Business, Nonfuel Retail and Digital ventures.* I'm excited to reiterate our unwavering commitment to these projects with a robust 1.5 lakh Crore investment over the next five years. From sapling to giant oak: 'Project Aspire' nurtures our ambitions of doubling profits and quadrupling the market cap.

During the year, we witnessed noteworthy achievements, including the foundation stone laid for Bina Petchem Refinery Expansion Project (BPREP) by Honorable Prime Minister for which BPCL has earmarked one third of its next five-year investments! And is easily the largest single point investment for our Company. By declaring FID of Rs ~5000Cr, we have also started yet another petrochemical project, poly propylene at KR. We have some more initiatives in the pipeline towards niche petrochemicals awaiting to be declared.

We made several significant innovations during the year, MR successfully produced import substitute Group III 100N Lube Oil, DAS splitter of LOBS unit was successfully commissioned and solvents D40/D80/D100 were made available to market. BPCL is the 5th producer in the world and the only producer of the product in India. Heavy oxo alcohol is one additional product added to KR petchem product portfolio from Oxo alcohol unit of Petchem complex at Kochi. BR achieved additional energy efficiency through initiatives like Micro-turbine installation in SRU and condensate recovery systems. CBG project at Kochi kickstarted with active support from local authority as a Green Initiatives of BPCL simultaneously will aid to alleviate the air pollution affecting the locality.

We have also commissioned 14MW Solar Power Project at BR. All these have facilitated to decreased Energy Intensity Index (EII) by 4 Number of each refinery, in comparison to respective figures of last year H1.

The year was remarkable! We had to, face the fury of Cyclone Biparjoy impacting crude supply at BR, delay in BR turnaround to meet products demand, faced lack of skilled manpower at MR turnaround, struggle with operational difficulties posed due to processing of challenging cheap Crudes, but we not only manage to wriggle out of the tough situation but also put on a stellar performance. The year also showed our advancements towards digitalization through use of RTLS systems, ODRs, corrosion control dash boards and AI/ML based predictive analytics. I'm confident that with the scale-up of these initiatives planned in the coming year, we will uncover new paths to optimize, innovate and contribute significantly towards reliability.

It is heartening to note that, staying true to our motto "Safety First Safety Must" we had no reportable fire incident or LTA in the time frame. It adds further joy that this feat was achieved whilst completing major turnarounds in the refineries. However, we shall not be complacent of this achievement and should be mindful of the near miss incidents that have occurred in the recent past. I'm sure, as always, my team will rise to the occasion and address the same to avoid recurrence.

It's also exciting to note that BR has won "Refinery of the Year' (Capacity < 9 MMTPA) by FIPI and 'Refiner of The Year' in Economic Times Energy Leadership Awards, while KR has won Refinery of the Year award (Capacity >9 MMTPA)' at FIPI Oil & Gas Awards 2022 and Gold Medal in the National Awards for Manufacturing Competitiveness (NAMC 2022) by International Research Institute for Manufacturing and MR won "The Golden Peacock Environment Management Award 2023 for best environmental practices and FICCI Industry 4.0 Award for Overall Digitalization Category.

I am confident that our spirit of unity and unwavering pursuit of progress will propel us to even greater heights. May the coming year be filled with abundant opportunities, groundbreaking discoveries, and a renewed sense of purpose as we chart our course towards a sustainable and prosperous. Dear Team,

At the outset my happiest wishes to each one of you for a grand New Year. We bid farewell to 2023 with much gratitude, as it has been a spectacular year of performance and bold new promises.

It is exciting to note that 2023 is bidding adieu with wonderful parting gifts. The prestigious Polypropylene (PP) Unit has received the final nod for activation at Kochi Refinery. The 400 KTPA PP Unit at Rs.5044 Crs will soon have a pride of place with other KR Units for producing various grades of Homo Polypropylene and thus increase the Petrochemical portfolio. BPCL's proposal for setting up a bio-methanation plant of 150 TPD capacity at Kochi by converting Biodegradable Waste into Compressed Bio Gas (CBG) has been welcomed by the Government of Kerala and the first unit is coming up by December 2024.

In fact, we set the year 2023 on a fast pace, improving our own records month after month. Firstly, we achieved the highest ever total petrochemicals production of 28.2 TMT and Butyl Acrylate production of 16.3 TMT breaking our own records, consecutively in the same year. We also added a brand-new product, Heavy Oxo Alcohol (Packed) to our product portfolio.

We had the 1500th tanker, berthing at our SPM and we also set the record of dispatching 5 million metric tons of Petcoke with the 1511th rake dispatch in August 2023. Two months down, we recorded the highest ever MS production of 385 TMT in Oct 2023 and then set the highest ever LPG production and evacuation of 112.6/109.6 TMT in Nov'23. Collaborating with the Corporate R&D Centre, we successfully completed the trial run and produced 4500 MT of Anode Grade Pet Coke at the Delayed Coker unit. The KSPPL LPG pipeline from the Refinery to Palakkad was also successfully commissioned in 2023.

The 82.0 million accident-free man-hours that we clocked on 14 December 2023, stands testimony to our continued commitment to the core mantra - Safety First, Safety Must with extra emphasis on this during planned and unplanned turnarounds.

Kochi, a destination with famed tourist locales is home to the largest PSU refinery and many other unique installations. With the Bharat Petroleum Learning Centre Annexe in Kochi, the ultra-modern state-of-the art Learning Centre that was jointly launched recently by Director (HR) Shri Raj Kumar Dubey and Director (Refineries) Shri Sanjay Khanna, we have added a new destination to support industry wide knowledge quests.

Once again let us revel in the recognitions bestowed on the team in the year that went by. The Gold Medal in the National Awards for Manufacturing Competitiveness (NAMC 2022), 'Refinery of the Year (Capacity more than 9 MMTPA)' award at FIPI Oil & Gas Awards 2022 and National Awards for excellence in PSU in the categories of Corporate Social Responsibility, Digital Initiatives and Environmental Sustainability; endorsed by Business Leader of the Year Award, World HRD Congress. We were also very recently appreciated for the consistent and meritorious performance in energy conservation at the National Energy Conservation Awards 2023, by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE). Kudos on the recognitions received both in individual and team categories, at the first National Awards for Corrosion Management, instituted by the Confederation of Indian Industry in association with Niti Ayog.

With big wins and small, our aspirations as a team have gained more focus with BPCL's Project Aspire and we have now to tread deeply focused on it. Each of us have immense contributions to make and be a part of that bigger picture envisaged for our company by doubling profits and quadrupling market capitalisation in the next five years. RS. 5044 CRORE FOR POLYPROPYLENE PRODUCTION PP UNIT COMING UP AT KOCHI REFINERY

Responding to India's burgeoning demand for petrochemicals, BPCL proudly announced a groundbreaking initiative aimed at shaping a sustainable future in December 2023. With an investment of Rs. 5,044 Crore, BPCL is set to establish a Polypropylene (PP) Unit at Kochi Refinery.

This visionary project leverages the abundant Propylene feedstock at Kochi Refinery, marking a significant milestone in reshaping the petrochemical industry landscape. The Polypropylene Unit, boasting a production capacity of 400 Kilo-Tonnes Per Annum, is strategically designed to meet market demands and reinforces BPCL's commitment to downstream industries.

Mr. G Krishnakumar, C&MD, BPCL, shared "Our Rs. 5,044 Crore investment in the Kochi Refinery's Polypropylene Unit is part of our strategic commitment towards a sustainable future. Addressing India's petrochemical demand, this project will reshape the industry, meeting the requirements for Packaging Films, Containers and more."

Polypropylene, a versatile material, finds applications in Packaging Films, Sheets, Boxes, Containers, Bags, Home Ware, Home Care, Personal Care, and everyday articles. The project is slated for completion in approximately 46 months, signaling BPCL's dedication to driving innovation and meeting the evolving needs of the market.

This initiative builds upon BPCL's existing capabilities, with the operation of a Propylene Derivative Petrochemical Plant (PDPP) at Kochi Refinery. PDPP has been instrumental in producing critical import substitutes, including acrylic acid, acrylates, oxo-alcohol, and other niche petrochemicals. Notably, PDPP was dedicated to the nation by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi in February 2021, underscoring BPCL's commitment to the vision of Atma Nirbhar Bharat.

As BPCL takes this momentous step towards a sustainable future, the company remains steadfast in its mission to contribute to India's economic growth, promote self-reliance, and advance the petrochemical industry. This endeavor aligns with the broader objectives of Atma Nirbhar Bharat, reflecting BPCL's commitment to driving positive change and fostering a resilient and self-sufficient nation.

Envisaged to support concurrent programmes in addition to the BPLC facility at Sewree, the BPLC Annexe at Kochi is a unique water-front facility, approximately 40 Kms from the Cochin International Airport and 15 Kms from the Ernakulam Railway station. It is equipped with four completely digital training halls and 14 break-out rooms; with a training capacity of 220 at one go. Other facilities here include an L&D room, AR/VR Room & E library, separate VIP rooms, Board Room, amphitheater and roof-top dining facilities.

The refurbishment of the former Kochi Refinery City office (basement, ground and 5 floors) involved interior, exterior, electrical, plumbing, AC systems, firefighting facilities, audio /video systems, external civil works and landscaping. The revamp started on 2 May 2023 and was transformed into the BPLC Annexe within five months on 23 Oct 2023 at a total project cost of approximately Rs.12.30 Crs. The Kochi Refinery Estates team represented by Mr. Johnson K, DGM(Admn & Estates) and Mr. Shijil Subash PS, Manager (Estates) presented the transformational journey of the BPLC Annexe.

The five storied learning centre is the new incarnation of an architectural wonder originally designed by celebrated US born Indian Architect and Urban Planner, Mr. Christopher Charles Benninger in 2001. Over two decades later, today it echoes the vision of Corporate HR brought to reality by the Kochi Refinery team as the BPLC Kochi. A place, where lights, accentuated spaces, the blue sky and surrounding greens, open up splendid vistas for a perfect learning experience. The first programme is scheduled to take-off at the BPLC Kochi in the first week of the New Year.





BIG WINS AT CII NATIONAL CORROSION MANAGEMENT MEET

Team BPCL bagged big wins at the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), National Corrosion Management Practices-Competitions & Awards 2023. The forum is one of the crucial components of CII's mission on the "War against Corrosion", launched in collaboration with Niti Ayog.

BPCL emerged winner of the Corrosion Management Champion Organisation (Category-I). The team members representing BPCL were Dr. Jaya Rawat, (CRDC, Noida), Mr Prasanth KS (CMRO-Reliability), Mr. Anurag Gautam (Inspection-Kochi Refinery) Mr. Sumit Bansal (Inspection- Mumbai Refinery), Mr. Mastram Hathesh (Inspection- Bina Refinery) and Mr. Aishwariy Baheti (Digital- Mumbai Refinery). The accolade recognizes the refinery's dedication to ensuring the longevity and reliability of its infrastructure.

BPCL Refineries' commitment to using latest technologies in corrosion management was much lauded with the first prize for the Best Case Study on Use of IoT/Digitization/Innovation in Corrosion Monitoring & Management (Category-3). Mr. Sanal S and Mr. Gokuldas KK from the Inspection team of Kochi Refinery bagged the award for the case-study on use of Augmented reality (AR) based 3D scanning in PFCCU Regenerator & Reactor Cyclones and Drone based inspection of PFCCU Regenerator (KR).

The accolade speaks volumes about BPCL Refineries' commitment to sustainable and effective corrosion management practices

The best Case Study, prize on Corrosion Management under Asset integrity Systems/ Concrete Structures (Category-5) for FCCU CO Boiler RCC stack (MR) was presented to Mr. Ravindra Lanjewar (Inspection- Mumbai Refinery). The competition in corrosion management by CII aims to recognize and promote effective corrosion management practices across industries. 


