# Have 'atom bomb' to prove EC helping BJP steal votes: Rahul

'Will Not Spare Officials Tied To Vote Theft'

Rahul and opposition parties have demanded immediate discussion on review of Bihar poll rolls.

New Delhi: Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Friday said his party has collected "atom bomb" of evidence to prove that EC is helping the ruling BJP steal votes, stepping up his attack on "vote theft" on a day he led the joint opposition in writing to the Lok Sabha Speaker demanding an immediate discussion on the review of electoral rolls in Bihar.

## Ignore Rahul's 'threats', EC to poll officials

New Delhi: Election Commission on Friday said it prefers to ignore Rahul Gandhi's baseless allegations of "vote theft" and has asked all poll officials to continue working in impartial and transparent manner.

In a post on X, the commission said it was unfortunate that Rahul was hurling unfounded allegations at EC and poll officials and repeatedly threatening them through media statements with irresponsible phrases like "vote theft", "over a year after conclusion of the Lok Sabha poll", it said neither Rahul nor Congress availed of "options available under the law" such as appeals against wrongful inclusion/exclusion of electors by the ERO in the final roll or challenge an election by filing an election petition within the stipulated time (4 days after declaration of result).

EC said that it had sent a mail to Rahul on June 12 after he alleged irregularities in Maharashtra polls. In a newspaper article he was asked to write to the EC directly or meet a panel, but he did not respond. Interestingly, none of the allegations made by Rahul in his article, or any other grievance of his, has been directly communicated to EC.

"It is very strange and deplorable that he is making wild allegations and has now even started threatening EC and its staff," EC said. In the post on X, the commission underlined that while Rahul Gandhi has been attacking EC over alleged "vote theft" during the Lok Sabha poll in Karnataka, the fact is that the electoral roll was prepared by 31 district election officers (DEOs) and assistant DEOs (ADEOs) and assistant EROs and 80,834 booth level officers (BLOs), with the due involvement of booth level agents appointed by all political parties.

Govt cites Jakhar precedent, says talks on SIR unlikely

New Delhi: Despite mounting anxiety to get key legislations passed, government Friday indicated that a discussion on EC's Special Intensive Revision (SIR) being demanded by opposition, may not be feasible.

Sources in the govt pointed out that the EC is conceived as an independent entity. They also said that former Speaker Balam Jakhar had turned down a demand for a discussion on EC's functioning precisely for this reason. The clarification came even as the two houses faced another washout on Friday, due to opposition's insistence on discussing the SIR of electoral rolls.

While the opposition looks set to persist with its protests, govt seems to be preparing for scenario where they may have to get key legislations, including IT (Amendment) Act, Manu Bill and another bill on the implementation of GST in the state with a law passed amid disruptions.

Parliamentary affairs minister K. J. Somaiya emphasised that the decision on whether to allow a discussion on EC's decision to conduct SIR rests with the LS and RS Chairmen. Raju also said that Jakhar as Lok Sabha Speaker (1990-95) had ruled that the EC can't be discussed in the House. "A precedent exists, and we will follow it," he said.

# Election for new Vice-President set for Sept 9: EC

New Delhi: The Election Commission on Friday announced that the election of Vice-President of India, fixing Aug 7 as the date of issue of this poll notification and Sept 9 as the date of poll, in what could end the BJP leadership to get into a bubble to decide its nominees, succeed in upholding the former VP's bid to return on July 22, on "health grounds".

Counting of votes to be held by the Vice-Presidential electoral college — which will comprise 702 MPs including 542 elected members of the Lok Sabha as well as 250 elected and 12 nominated members of Rajya Sabha — will be held on Sept 9 itself as on after the polling concludes. Though the total strength of the two Houses is 710, there is currently one vacancy in the Lok Sabha from Bhaichand in West Bengal and five in RS — one from Punjab and four from J&K.

The value of vote of each MP is the same, that is, one. All MPs must vote by secret ballot. Political parties cannot issue any whip to their MPs for voting in a Vice-Presidential election.

EC on Friday said nomination may be filed between Aug 7 and 21. Nomination papers will be scrutinised on Aug 22, and candidates can withdraw their nomination till Aug 25. Polling, if necessary, will be held on Sept 9 at Parliament House.

Although UPV stands no chance of winning in polls, they are likely to field a nominee they consider symbolic.
