# Fanning the Winds of Change: BPCL Awards Contracts for Setting Up 100 MW Windfarm Projects

**Mumbai, May 7, 2025: Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL),** a Fortune Global 500 company, and one of India's leading oil and gas companies, announced today, that they have awarded contracts for the development of 100 MW Windfarm Projects—50 MW each in the states of Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.
