NOTICE INVITING TENDER

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1. Introduction:

BPCL Mumbai Refinery (MR) has crude processing capacity of 12.0 million Metric Tonnes per Annum (MMTPA). The refining capacity has been augmented to the present level through progressive revamps, addition of various process units and incorporation of advanced refining technologies.

BPCL intends to set up a Petro Resid Fluidized Catalytic Cracking (PRFCC) unit.

Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) has awarded M/s. Technip Energies India Limited (T.EN) an EPCM Contract for overall project management, residual & detail engineering, process design/ Engineering, Procurement & Expediting services, Tendering, Construction Management, QA / QC & supervision, HSE Management & Support in Commissioning & PGTR.

BPCL intends to execute the Reactor & Regenerator Package and Associated Facilities Project at Mumbai Refinery, on a Lumpsum Package Basis, with single point responsibility by the Contractor for the entire Scope of Work.

Brief details of the Process Units covered under this tender are highlighted below:

2.1 Petro Resid Fluidized Catalytic Cracker (3MMTPA) and Associated Facilities:

A new Petro Resid Fluidized Catalytic Cracking (PRFCC) of capacity 3 MMTPA. PRFCCU process converts a feed mixture consisting of Vacuum Residue (VR), Vacuum Gas Oil (VGO) and Un-Converted Oil (UCO) into Propylene, High Octane Gasoline, Light Cycle Oil, and Slurry Oil. Additionally, off gases are also produced. The main intent of the process is to maximize Propylene production.



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2.2 Propylene Recovery Unit (Part) and Associated Facilities:

Propylene Recovery Unit (PRU) separates chemical grade Propylene, and Mixed C4s from treated LPG.

4. Eligible Bidders:

4.1 Bidder Qualification Criteria (BQC):

Bidder shall meet the minimum qualification criteria, detailed out in the Bidder Qualification Criteria (BQC). Bidder, who has signed the Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) with Licensor, shall be given access for viewing / downloading the tender document.

4.1.1 General Requirements:

If the supporting documents submitted by Bidder are not in English language, then the English translation copy of the same shall also be furnished duly certified, stamped and signed by Local Chamber of Commerce or Indian Embassy in their country or Bidder's Embassy in India or any translator in India recognized / authorized by Bidder's Embassy.

All Copies of BQC supporting documents to be submitted by successful Bidder should be duly verified with originals & attested by TPIA which is registered under "NABCB accredited bodies as per requirement of ISO/IEC17020/25 as Type A" in QCI's NABCB website (<https://nabcb.qci.org.in/inspection-body/>) as on the date of attestation. Cost of TPIA certification shall be borne by the Bidder. In this regard, the Bidder shall submit undertaking listed under relevant clause of Attachment-A to ITB.

Bidder does not need to provide original TPIA verified documents along with bid. Undertaking by Bidder towards submission of TPIA verified documents needs to be provided as per format (refer to relevant clause of Attachment-A to ITB), giving assurance to submit TPIA verified documents in case they are successful Bidder. Refusal to submit the undertaking by the Bidder shall be considered as one of the rejection criteria for bid evaluation and bid of successful Bidder may be rejected for the same reason.

4.1.2 Other Requirements:

4.1.2.1 Independent ESI (Employees State Insurance) Code:

Bidder shall have Indian ESI registration in their own name. Bidder shall submit a copy of the registration certificate along with the Bid. Refer to ITB for additional details.

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4.1.2.2 PF (Provident Fund) Registration:

Bidder shall have Indian PF registration in their own name and shall submit copy of the PF registration certificate Bid. Refer to ITB for additional details.

Note: Refer to ITB for details of other documents to be submitted with the Bid.

4.2 Consortium / JV Bidding:

Consortium / JV Bidding is not allowed for this tender.

4.3 Already engaged by Owner to provide Licensing or Services for this Project:

A firm which has been engaged by BPCL/Owner to provide licensing or technical/consultancy services for this Project (here "Project" shall mean the project embracing the works and/or unit(s) forming the subject matter of the Bid and resultant Contract) and any of its affiliates that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with that firm, are disqualified from executing the works on Lumpsum Package Basis for the same project and are also disqualified from participating in this tender. Conversely a firm hired for executing the works on Lumpsum Package Basis for implementation of this Project and any of its affiliates, are disqualified from providing services related to the initial assignment for the same Project

4.4 Conflict of interest with other Bidders:

The Bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Owner's interests. The Bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.

The Bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, under the following criteria:

- a) They have controlling partner (s) in common.
- b) They receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy / financial stake from any of them.
- c) They have the same legal representative / agent for purposes of this bid.
- d) They have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another Bidder.
- e) Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the Bid.

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- f) In case of a holding company having multiple closely sister companies, then only one such company should quote. Bidder must proactively declare such sister / common business / management units in same / similar line of business.

4.5 Submission of complete authentic information / documentation:

The Bidder shall ensure submission of complete authentic information / documentation along with the Bid. The Bidder found to have deviated from this requirement, shall be disqualified.

Wherever specific compliance with the relevant documentation submitted by Bidder is required post Bid submission, Owner/Consultant reserves the right to directly interact with the Bidder's Owner/Consultants to verify the relevant documentation, and the Bidder will render necessary assistance in facilitating the same.

Bidder shall also render assistance in facilitating visits to the reference units, if considered necessary by Owner/Consultant. Cost of such visit shall not be to the Bidder's account.

4.6 Cartel Formation:

In case any Bidder is found to be involved in Cartel formation, such bid will not be considered for evaluation/ placement of order. The Bidder will also be debarred from bidding in future.

4.7 Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA):

Bidder will be required to enter into a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) directly with the process Licensor, after which, the access to the detailed technical section of the bid will be provided to those Bidders who have signed the NDA. It is the responsibility of the Bidder to get the NDA signed as applicable. Delay in signing NDA shall not be the reason for any extension on bid submission due date. Any Bidder rejected/considered not acceptable by the process Licensor(s), will not be allowed to participate in the tendering process. For the format of NDA, Refer to relevant clause of Attachment-A to ITB.

4.8 Holiday / Negative list:

Bidder who is on Holiday / Negative list of Owner/Licensor/ Consultant/ MoPNG on due date of issuance of Tender/submission of bid/ during the process of evaluation of the bids, the offers of such Bidders shall not be considered for bid opening/evaluation/award. If the Bidding Document is/was issued inadvertently to such Bidder/downloaded from website by such Bidder, then bid submitted by such Bidder shall not be considered for opening / evaluation / award. Refer Attachment-A to ITB for Policy of Holiday Listing of Vendors in BPCL.

4.9 Qualification based on engaging DEC:

Refer to relevant clause of BQC.

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4.10 Insolvency, liquidation, court receivership or other similar proceedings:

No insolvency, liquidation, court receivership or other similar proceedings shall have been initiated and pending against the Bidder. The Bidder shall submit a self-certificate/declaration stating that they are not under insolvency, liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings or submit the details of the same. Failure to do so or if the Bidder is under insolvency, liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, their bids shall not be considered. Bidder should submit a self-certificate/declaration regarding the same, as per format given in relevant clause of Attachment-A to ITB. Owner reserves it's right to evaluate and finalize the Bid, without considering the bid of any party undergoing insolvency resolution process or liquidation or bankruptcy proceeding, regardless of the stage of tendering.

Bidder should submit a self-certificate/declaration regarding the same, as per relevant clause of Attachment-A to ITB.

4.11 Fraudulent Practices:

Bidders found to be indulging in fraudulent practices shall be subject to appropriate action as per the provisions defined in ITB clause 26.

4.12 Canvassing in any form by the Bidder:

Canvassing in any form by the Bidder or by any other agency on their behalf, may lead to disqualification of their Bid.

Note: With reference to the above clauses, Bidder shall refer to the relevant documents provided in the ITB and also provide necessary declarations as per relevant clause in Attachment-A to ITB, in their letter head duly signed and stamped by their Power of Attorney (POA) holder along with their bid. Non-submission of these declarations shall render their bid liable for rejection.

5. Brief Scope of Work for Reactor & Regenerator Package and Associated Facilities:

The brief scope of work shall include Project Management, Residual Process Design, Detailed Engineering (including HAZOP/ SIL study), procurement, fabrication, inspection, transportation of all the equipment's/ materials to work site, storage, assembly, erection, installation, construction and testing of all above mentioned facilities, including statutory approvals, and to achieve mechanical completion, precommissioning, commissioning, performance guarantee test run (PGTR) and handing over of all the facilities to Owner, including supply of mandatory/ recommended spares.

The project shall be executed based on detailed Scope of Work, Scope of Material Supply, Schedule of Rates / Price Schedule, Specifications, Standards and drawing, that have been included in the Tender/ITB document (including Addendums / Amendments). For detailed scope, refer to the relevant technical sections of the Tender Document.



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6. Project Location:

The facilities envisaged under the Project for Reactor & Regenerator Package (RR Package) and associated facilities, are proposed to be located within the premises of the Mumbai Refinery (MR) of Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL), in Mumbai, Maharashtra. The project site is near the coastal area. Details of the project facilities is given in the relevant technical section of the Tender Document & SCC.

The Bidder should inspect the site and familiarize themselves with the site & local conditions before submitting their bid.

7. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid Security:

Bids must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit / Bid Security. Bids not accompanied with requisite Earnest Money Deposit / Bid Security (or authenticated exemption certificate, wherever applicable), shall be considered non-responsive and such Bids shall be summarily rejected.

Refer to relevant details provided in relevant clause of ITB & Attachment-A to ITB.

8. Forfeiture of EMD / Security Deposit:

For conditions regarding Forfeiture of Bid Security, refer to relevant clause of ITB.

9. General:

- a) The subject tender is an e-tender & can be downloaded from BPCL website, <https://bpcltenders.eproc.in>
- b) The tender document will not be issued in person or sent by post. Mere obtaining tender document through BPCL website shall, however, not be construed that the bidder/agency is considered qualified. Bidder is mandated to get enrolled on e-Tendering portal (<https://bpcltenders.eproc.in>) and enroll their Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).
- c) Bidder is advised to read the instructions for participating in the e-tendering from the website <https://bpcltenders.eproc.in/>. The Help Documentation placed at Home Page provides necessary guidance to bidders for using the e-Tendering site. Bidder shall use their existing user ID or create a new ID for logging into the portal for participation in e-tendering. Procedure for Vendor Registration on BPCL Portal is available in relevant clause of Attachment-A to ITB.
- d) Special Instruction to Bidder for e-tendering procedure, is enclosed as part of tender document, refer to relevant clause Attachment-A to ITB. Bidder shall download the Bidding Document in his own name and submit the bid directly. The Bidding Document is non-transferable. Bid submitted by Bidder who has not downloaded the bidding document either directly or through their authorized person, will be rejected. Only the person having Power of Attorney to do bidding process on behalf of the Bidder, shall submit/upload the bid document using their own Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).



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- e) The Bidding Document is non-transferable. The Bidding Document is and shall remain the exclusive property of the Owner with a right for the Bidder to use it only for the intended purpose of bidding and for use by the successful Bidder with reference to the resultant Contract for the Owner's subject Unit. The Bidder shall take due measures to keep the documents secret and confidential (wherever specifically mentioned) and shall disclose the Bidding Document and/or furnish copies in whole or part thereof to employees involved in the preparation of the Bid who have understood the proprietary and confidential nature of the documents and have undertaken to be bound by and maintain confidentiality.
- f) All direct and indirect costs associated with the preparation and submission of bid (including clarification meetings and site visit, if any), shall be to Bidder's account and Owner will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
- g) The Bidding Document shall be read in conjunction with any amendment issued subsequently. The Bidder is expected to examine the Bidding Document, including all instructions, terms, specifications and drawings in the Bidding Document. Failure to furnish all information required as per the Bidding Document or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Document in every respect could result in rejection of the Bid.
- h) The details presented in this Bidding Document have been compiled with all reasonable care. However, it is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that the information provided is adequate, clearly understood and it includes all documents as per the Index. Bidder is requested to clarify all the queries related to tender before the bid opening, within the Last date for submission of Pre-bid Queries and ensure compliance with all provisions of the bidding document.
- i) The Bidder is expected prior to the submission of its/his/their bid, as a prudent and experienced Contractor to make its/his/their own assessment of all the requirements of the work and of the accuracy, correctness and completeness of any estimate, data, or information furnished by the Owner/Consultant in the Tender Documents and of the availability, suitability, propriety, adequacy and/or soundness of any suggestion made by the Owner/Consultant in the Tender Documents also referred to as "Tender".
- j) All documents furnished by the Bidder in support of meeting the Bidder's Qualification Criteria (BQC) shall be certified by person holding POA. All documents submitted by the Bidder towards meeting BQC shall be furnished in a separate booklet titled "Documentation against Bidder Qualification Criteria" with proper indexing.
- k) Submission of authentic documents is the prime responsibility of the Bidder. The Bidder shall ensure submission of complete authentic information/ documentation along with the bid. No amount of checking or verification by the Owner/Consultant shall absolve Bidder from his responsibility. Moreover, Bidder's organization is responsible for all actions of their employees and any claims seeking to pinpoint the blame on some employee of Bidder and attempting to absolve the Bidder's organization, will not be entertained. Wherever Owner/Consultant has concern or apprehension regarding the authenticity / correctness of any document, Owner/Consultant reserves the right to get the documents verified from issuing authority/any relevant source. If documents (part or full) are found forged, such offers will be summarily

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rejected, EMD will be forfeited, purchase order/contract if any, placed against subject tender will be terminated and Bidder may be debarred from future tenders. For the purpose of verification of documents, Bidder shall submit complete client details with names, address, phone number, e-mail ID etc.

- l) Owner/Consultant reserves the right to carry out capacity & capability assessment of the Bidder using in-house information and past performance.
- m) Relevant supporting documents towards other specified requirements are also to be uploaded along with bid, failing which, bid is liable for rejection.
- n) Owner/Consultant reserves the right to reject any or all the bids or any parts of the bid received and may cancel the tender in part or full, extending the due date of tender submission etc., without assigning any reason.
- o) Legal dispute, if any, shall only be within the jurisdiction of Local Court, unless mentioned otherwise.
- p) All communication will be made through e-Tendering web site (<https://bpcltenders.eproc.in>). However, Owner/Consultant reserve the right to take cognizance of the communication made outside e-Tendering Portal under exceptional circumstances.
- q) Bidder cannot make any claim against Owner towards its expense incurred in connection with the preparation and delivery of their bid, participating in the discussion and other expenses incurred during the bidding process.
- r) Offers not meeting statutory requirements are liable for rejection.
- s) Bidders are advised to visit Announcement section/ Information for DSC/ Bidders Manual Kit/ FAQ of e-Tender Portal, before bidding.
- t) Any Addendum/Corrigendum/Bid submission date extension in respect of above Tender shall only be issued on BPCL website: <https://bpcltenders.eproc.in/> and no separate notification shall be issued in the press or any other media. Bidders are therefore requested to regularly visit our website to keep themselves updated. Any Addendum/Amendment thus issued shall become part of Bidding Document. Bidder shall submit a copy of the Addendum/Amendment duly signed and stamped along with all relevant documents/information (if applicable as per Addendum) as a token of their acceptance. Failure of the Bidder to submit Bid without taking cognizance of Amendment issued by Consultant/Owner shall be liable for rejection.
- u) Owner/Consultant does not take any responsibility for the correctness of tender documents obtained from any other source. Bidders are advised to visit above mentioned website before submitting their offer for official version of the tender document including any corrigendum / amendment if any, which shall be binding on the Bidder.
- v) Owner shall also follow the Public Procurement Policy on Procurement of Goods and services from Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order 2012.

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- w) In case of an MSE Bidder, documentary evidence as per the prevailing Government policy shall be acceptable. Additionally, duly authenticated documents (CA Certified) in this regard shall be submitted in original. - y) Bidder shall submit the Integrity Pact agreement & the Declaration from Bidder regarding acceptance and compliance with the Integrity Pact Program in the prescribed Formats (enclosed in the Tender Document, refer to relevant details provided in ITB) duly signed along with the Bid.
- z) Hard copies/Fax/ e-mail bids shall not be accepted.

- gg) The Bidder is also expected prior to finalization of its/his/their bid to visit and examine the job site and its surroundings, to familiarize itself/himself/themselves of the ground realities, the availability, existence and suitability of facilities, sources of supply required for the work(s), the environmental conditions which can be encountered, collect all data and other information which the Bidder may require for preparation and formulation of its/his/their bid. The Contractor will not to be entitled to make any claim against the Owner or to raise any objection or defense

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against any claim based on the ignorance of existing or expected conditions, or on the lack of adequate information, or of any plan, estimate or expectation based on a different perception or expectation or information.

- hh) The Bidder before bidding, shall be deemed to have undertaken a thorough study of the proposed work, the job site(s) involved, the site conditions, soil conditions, the terrain, the climatic conditions, local conditions, availability of labour, power, material, and equipment, transport and communications facilities, availability and suitability of laydown areas within the Refinery, fabrication yards outside the Refinery, availability of land for right of way and temporary office, quarters for accommodation outside the Refinery, availability and route survey for supply of materials and the performance of work, and all other facts and facilities necessary or relevant for the preparation of the bid.
- ii) Unsolicited clarifications to the offer and / or change in the prices during the validity period would render the bid liable for rejection.
- jj) Techno-commercial part of the Bid shall be opened on the specified due date and time. Time and date of opening of Price Bids shall be notified through e-portal to the qualified and acceptable Bidders, at a later date. Bidders may view the Bid opening through

- ll) The Bidder shall quote their most competitive rates. Negotiations will not be conducted with Bidder as a matter of routine. However, Owner reserves the right to conduct negotiations.
- mm) Bidder should make sure that their Price Bid (Part-II) contains only prices. Rates mentioned elsewhere shall not be taken into cognizance. Offer shall be liable for rejection if any condition directly or implied, is recorded by Bidder in the Priced Bid (Part-II).
- nn) The offer of the Bidder shall remain valid for 06 (Six) months from the last date of submission of Tender / Revised offer (if applicable as permitted by the Owner). On account of exigencies, if Bidder is asked to extend their bid validity, the same should be extended by Bidder without any deviation, and without any change in the prices. However, in this case, the Bidder would be allowed to withdraw their bid. If Bidder still deviates or changes price, its bid would likely to be rejected.
- oo) Fax of Acceptance (FOA) /LOA (Letter of Acceptance) will be issued by the Owner to the successful Bidder.
- pp) It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to get their BQC documents considered for qualification successfully verified by a third-party inspection agency (TPIA), who is registered under "NABCB accredited bodies ([Inspection Body – NABCB](#))", as per requirement of ISO/IEC17020 as Type A" in QCI NABCB website, as on date of verification of documents.

If there are no changes in the document data and the document is already verified & attested by the above independent third-party inspection agency (TPIA) for the Bidder, such verified

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documents can be submitted for qualifying the BQC without again verification and attestation from above TPIA.

Bidder should ensure and submit BQC data only for those executed works that are meeting the qualification criteria, for which they can arrange such verification by (TPIA). Failure of cross verification executed works that are not meeting the qualification criteria, shall entitle Consultant/Owner to reject the bid or terminate the Purchase Order / Contract, if already issued.
