EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 173(2) OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 1956, IN RESPECT OF THE BUSINESS UNDER ITEM NO. 2. IS ANNEXED HERETO.

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

"RESOLVED that, in supercession of the Resolution passed at the Extraordinary General Meeting held on 8th December, 1981, and pursuant to clauses (a) & (d) of sub-section (1) of section 293 and other enabling provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 1956, and subject to the approval of the President as required under Articles 45 and 46 of the Articles of Association of the Company, consent be and is hereby granted to the Board of Directors of the Company to borrow for the purposes of the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained from and/or to be obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business) such sum or sums of money from the Government of India and/or its agencies, Company's bankers and/or from any other person or persons, firms. bodies corporate, national financial institutions or international financial institutions by way of deposits, advances or other loans, whether unsecured or secured by mortgage, charge. hypothecation or pledge of all or any of the Company's assets and properties including the whole or substantially the whole of the undertaking or undertakings of the Company on such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors may deem fit, NOTWITHSTANDING THAT the moneys to be borrowed together with the moneys already borrowed by the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained and/or to be obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business) will or may exceed the aggregate of the paid up capital of the Company and its free reserves i.e. reserves not set apart for any specific purpose, PROVIDED HOWEVER THAT the total moneys so borrowed (including the moneys already borrowed) shall not exceed Rs. 250 crores (exclusive of interest: at any one time and that the consent be and is hereby given to the Board of Directors for executing such instruments and documents if and when necessary by way of mortgage, charge, hypothecation or pledge or otherwise in connection with the borrowings of the Company as the Roard of Directors may think fit."

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 173(2) OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 1956


By a Special Resolution passed at the Extraordinary General Meeting of the Company held on 8th December, 1981, consent was granted to the Board of Directors of the Company to borrow, for the purposes of the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained from and/or to be obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business), moneys in excess of the paid up capital of the Company and its free reserves, subject to the condition that the moneys to be borrowed together with the moneys already borrowed by the Company did not exceed Rs. 150 crores (exclusive of interest) at any one time and that the consent was also accorded to the Board of Directors for executing such instruments and documents by way of mortgage, charge, hypothecation or pledge or otherwise in connection with the said borrowings as may be required.


The borrowings so far approved by the Board aggregate to Rs. 125.20 crores apart from Public Deposits amounting to Rs. 19.37 crores (total Rs. 144.57 crores).

For financing the capital expenditure on various projects and also to avail of the World Bank Loan as well as mobilise further Public Deposits, it is necessary to raise the existing borrowing powers of the Board.

As per the approved Annual Plan for 1983-84, the additional borrowings during 1983-84 would amount to Rs. 33.22 crores bringing the total expected borrowings to Rs. 177.79 crores (Rs. 144.57 crores = Rs. 33.22 crores).

In order to provide for further borrowings during the following years also, it is considered that the ceiling on borrowing powers of the Board may be raised from Rs. 150 crores to Rs. 250 crores.





DIVIDEND

The Project Agreement dated 5th May, 1982 between the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank) and your Corporation for the grant of loan amounting to US \$ 45 Million to the Corporation for





Additional Secondary Processing Facilities Project provides that, except as the World Bank may otherwise agree, the Corporation will not. declare any dividend (except dividends prescribed to be paid, pursuant to its Articles of Association or other understanding among its shareholders, as of December 15, 1981) if after the payment of such dividend, its current ratio would be less than 1.3:1. As this condition was not fulfilled last year, it was resolved at the Annual General Meeting held on 23rd September, 1982 that the payment of dividend @ 14% as declared or at such lower rate shall be made as may be agreed by the World Bank. As the World Bank has not so far signified its agreement, the amount of Rs. 2,03,53,669 on this account has been shown under "current liabilities"

Since the said condition is also not fulfilled during the year under report, your Directors have not recommended any dividend for the year 1982-83.

CONTRIBUTION TO EXCHEQUER

Your Corporation has contributed Rs. 367.73, crores to the Exchequer by way of duties and income tax during the year under report compared to Rs. 335.96 crores last year.

FINANCES


The outstanding amount of the term loan taken by the Corporation from the Oil Industry Development Board stood at Rs. 21.20 crores as at 31st March, 1983. The short term borrowings from banks and others amounted to Rs. 58.35 crores as at 31st March, 1983 as against Rs. 63.18 crores as at 31st March, 1982. Internal cash generation amounted to Rs. 29.36 crores as against Rs. 24.25 crores in the previous year.


PUBLIC DEPOSITS

The Public Deposit Scheme introduced in July 1981 gained considerable momentum and the amount of deposits collected stood at Rs. 19.37 crores at the close of the year compared to Rs. 3.60 crores at the close of last year. The total amount of deposits due for repayment and unclaimed as on 31st March, 1983 was Rs. 104,000 in respect of 3 depositors, which has since been paid/renewed.

NET WORTH

The net worth of the Corporation increased by Rs. 13.96 crores from Rs. 76.35 crores as at






31st March, 1982 to Rs. 90.31 crores as at 31st March, 1983.


REFINING

Illegal Strike: The extremely disturbed IR situation resulting in a total illegal strike by all workmen from mid-January 1982, as reported last year, continued into financial year 1982-83 till 17th June, 1982. All process units were shut down at the commencement of the strike and only utilities were kept operational. Resuming from January end onwards, crude distillation unit and solvent units were kept operating by Management Staff and all other units remained shut. Consequently, besides restricting the crude intake for the period, there was a shift in the product pattern. Further, the Textile Mills strike in Bombay continued, forcing alterations in the production pattern due to the continued low demand for LSHS. Subsequent to termination of the illegal strike, all the other units which had remained shut down throughout the strike period were started up one after the other and all activities were gradually normalised. The I.R. climate in the Refinery since then has been relatively undisturbed.

Crude Consumption: Crude consumption during the year under report was 4.48 million tonnes as against 4.99 million tonnes in the previous year. The performance would have been better but for the continuation of the strike through part of the year and the time taken to rehabilitate the Cat Cracker due to the monsoon after the strike was called off. Eleven different crudes were processed during the year. The quantity of Bombay High crude processed declined from 4.05 million tonnes in the previous year to 3.09 million tonnes. This was mainly due to the non-operation of the Cat Cracker during a major part of the year and the consequent LSHS disposal problem necessitating operation on Middle East crudes. To enable disposal of LSHS, rail loading facilities were constructed and commissioned ahead of schedule in March 1983.

Production: Total production of refined products during the year was 4.27 million tonnes compared to 4.76 million tonnes in the previous year. Due to the lower percentage of Bombay High crude in the crude mix, and





non-operation of some of the Units for a part of the year for reasons mentioned above, the yield was affected as under:—

- (a) Light distillates: The yield at 17.9% by weight on crude this year was lower than the corresponding figure of 20.0% in the previous year.
- (b) Middle distillates: The yield at 49.0% by weight on crude was lower than the corresponding figure of 51.1% last year.
- (c) Heavy ends: The yield at 28.5% was substantially higher than the corresponding figure of 24.1% in the previous year.
- (d) Fuel & Loss: The Refinery Fuel and Loss (excluding product transfer loss) during the year was lower at 4.58% by weight on crude processed as compared to 4.77% in the previous year.

Safety: One million manhours without lost time accident were achieved on 5th December, 1982 and 2 million manhours on 27th February, 1983.

MARKETING

Total sales during the year amounted to 5.75 million tonnes compared to 5.32 million tonnes in the previous year, with the Corporation's market participation rising to 16.8% versus 16.4% in the preceding year. The turnover increased from Rs. 1,515.42 crores in the previous year to Rs. 1,724.09 crores during the year under report. Foreign exchange earnings through International Aviation and Bunker sales amounted to Rs. 77.10 crores compared to Rs. 74.15 crores in the previous year.

The total number of Retail Outlets as at the end of March 1983 was 3,350 compared to 3,317 as at 31st March, 1982. The Multi-Purpose Distribution Centres and Farm Fuel Outlets numbered 70 and 42 respectively.

At the end of the year, the Corporation had 5 Port Installations, 2 Lubricating Oil Blending Plants and 59 Bulk Depots with a total tankage of 6.76 lakh kl. Construction work on a new Bulk Depot at Trivandrum is in progress. Tirunelveli and Coimbatore Bulk Depots are being resited. The Corporation owned and operated a tanklorry fleet of 148 vehicles. The Corporation has introduced with success the use of plastic seals for tanklorries to control malpractices. The Corporation handled 184.9 lakhs kl. product during the year.

On the LPG front, activities have been stepped up considerably and 3.57 lakhs new consumers

were enrolled during the period 1982-83 against a target of 3.50 lakhs. The number of LPG Distributors stood at 264 as at the end of March 1983 — a rise of over a hundred compared to end March 1982. Your Corporation has entered entirely new markets, where it was unrepresented hitherto, viz. Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Haryana, Punjab and U.P.

As the Industry's canalising agents for the import of LPG, the Corporation imported 49,247 tonnes of LPG during 1982-83 to supplement the indigenous availability.

Great stress has been laid to educate and inform the fast growing LPG consumer population regarding safety through comprehensive nationwide multi-media campaigns. Extensive press campaigns covered 18 publications all over the country in six regional languages apart from Hindi and English. Work is in hand to keep the safety angle alive in the public eye through television/radio networks, cinema slides, press and direct mailing.

With a view to further emphasise the consumers' interests, the Customer Service/Complaint Cells were expanded to cover 16 Regional Offices and 42 Depot Locations. Complaint/Suggestion Boxes have also been introduced at prominently located Retail Outlets/LPG Distributorships in major towns. The Service/Complaint Cells are periodically advertised through the press and/or other media.

The Corporation has also contributed towards petroleum conservation efforts through loan disbursement to customers to replace their boilers with newer fuel efficient equipment. Further, the Corporation has collaborated with Petroleum Conservation Research Association in their studies on fuel efficiency at customers' premises.

MAJOR PROJECTS

Additional Secondary Processing Facilities:
Due to the 5 month strike in the Refinery from mid January to mid June 1982, followed by the 3 months monsoon period, construction activity slowed down very ocnsiderably and resulted in a






slippage of 8 months for the project which is scheduled for completion by October 1984. However, as a result of the recovery planjointly agreed with Engineers India Ltd. (EIL). which is currently under implementation, and the very satisfactory construction progress achieved between January and May 1983, the likely slippage has been reduced to 3 months. and all out efforts are being put in to further reduce this slippage. Also, special efforts have been mounted to visit vendors' shops to assess progress and take corrective action as necessary As of end March 1983, the progress on detailed engineering, ordering and construction was 79%, 87% and 9% as against 45%, 42% and 3% as at end March 1982 respectively. Against an approved estimated cost of Rs. 133.34 crores, commitments amounted to Rs. 86.00 crores and capital expenditure incurred to Rs 41.43 crores upto 31st March, 1983 compared to the corresponding figures of Rs. 54.86 crores and Rs. 14.79 crores as at 31st March, 1982.

Aromatics from Bombay High Naphtha: The project for manufacturing 98,300 T/A of Benzene and 17,600 T/A of Toluene from 4 million T/A of Bombay High Crude is progressing as per schedule and is due for mechanical completion by April 1985. As of end March 1983, progress on detailed engineering and ordering was 28.5% and 25.5% respectively.

The Revised Feasibility Report, which had been submitted to the Government for approval, has been updated for October 1982 prices and the project is now estimated to cost Rs. 51.52 crores. Commitments made and expenditure incurred upto 31st March, 1983 were Rs 17.67 crores and Rs. 5.40 crores respectively.

Sulphur Recovery Project: A BPCL/EIL Team visited M/s. Comprime b.v., Netherlands in December 1982 and the process package for

the 5,700 T/A Sulphur Recovery Plant was frozen. Detailed engineering and ordering is in progress. The project, estimated to cost Rs. 9.37 crores, is scheduled for completion by June 1985.

Energy Conservation: The project estimated to cost Rs. 19.64 crores is being implemented in two phases:

Phase I: So as to hook-up the new facilities at the time of the CDU/HVU shutdown in April 1985, it is proposed to crash the project schedule for the new High Vacuum Unit Furnace, air-preheaters for the two CDU furnaces and installation of additional heat exchangers in the crude preheat train. Our recommendation for appointment of Consultant has been sent to the World Bank for approval.

Phase II: Work on the second phase, which essentially covers installation of a CO boiler for the existing FCC unit to be hooked up during the October 1986 FCC shutdown, will be taken up shortly.

Mandatory Crude Tankage: The project for the construction of 2 x 76,000 MT tanks is part of the Industry Phase II proposal for Mandatory Crude Tankage. Pile foundations for both the tanks have been completed and tank fabrication is in progress. Against an approved cost of Rs. 9.92 crores, commitment as at 31st March, 1983 was Rs. 5.13 crores and capital expenditure incurred was Rs. 3.00 crores. The project is scheduled for completion in June 1984.

Additional Product Tankage: In order to provide 45 days cover on the projected demand of major petroleum products during 1985-86, the Industry has planned for construction of additional product tankage at various installations/depots all over the country.

Under Phase I of the scheme, the Corporation will put up 2,90,562 kls tankage at various installations/depots at a total estimated cost of Rs. 23.57 crores. This phase of the project has since been approved by the Government. Action has already been initiated for procurement of steel, pipelines, etc. in order to adhere to schedule of completion in March 1985. In respect of tankage at Butcher Island, a part of this project, portion of land has already been taken from the Bombay Port Trust and work on site clearance, survey and soil investigations is on hand. Consultants have also been appointed and detailed engineering/procurement/tendering work is in progress.

Under Phase II-A, the Industry proposes to set up additional tankage of 7,79,158 kls at a total cost of Rs. 40.99 crores. The Corporation would be required to set up tankage of 2,46,361 kls at an estimated cost of Rs. 9.13 crores. The Project is awaiting Government's approval.

Marketing of LPG

- (a) Phase I: All work on this phase of the project for the marketing of the Corporation's share of 84,000 TPA out of the production of 168,000 TPA of LPG ex Bombay High Associated Gas has been completed except procurement of a few tankwagons for movement of bulk LPG due to inability of the Railways to provide the underframes in time. Out of the total estimated cost of Rs. 38.60 crores, actual expenditure incurred upto 31st March, 1983 amounted to approximately Rs. 37.30 crores. As planned, 5.7 lakh new domestic customers have been enrolled under this phase.
- Phase II: This phase, estimated to cost Rs. 23.98 crores, covers provision of facilities for marketing of 42,000 TPA of LPG, which is the Corporation's share of the incremental LPG from Mathura and Koyali FCCU, and would enable the Corporation to enrol 3 lakhs new domestic customers. Under this scheme, a 25,000 TPA Bottling Plant is being put up at Coimbatore and procurement of tankwagons, cylinders, valves and pressure regulators has been planned. Except for procurement of tankwagons, which depends on Railways' programme for supply of underframes, the project is on schedule and is expected to be completed by March 1984.
- (c) Phase III: The project involves marketing of an incremental volume of 8,43,600 tonnes of LPG by the Oil Industry arising out of the availability from Hazira Fractionation Unit, B. H. Uran Unit No. 2 and expansion programmes of Barauni, Cochin, Madras, Visakhapatnam and Bombay (BPCL) Refineries. The Corporation's share is estimated at 2.27 lakh TPA for which the investment of about Rs. 147.70 crores is envisaged. A total of 15.5 lakhs new domestic customers would be enrolled yielding a customer deposit of Rs. 54.25 crores.

The Corporation will put up 7 new Bottling Plants with a total filling capacity of

195,000 TPA and expand—its Delhi Bottling Plant from 25,000 TPA to 75,000 TPA. The Feasibility Report has been approved by the Government. The project is scheduled for completion by March 1988.

Aviation Fuel Hydrant System at Palam, Dethi: As an integral part of the New International Terminal Complex planned by the International Airport Authority of India at Delhi, it is proposed to provide a hydrant fuelling system to be constructed and operated by the Corporation on behalf of the Oil Industry. The project has been sanctioned by the Government at an estimated cost of Rs. 16.15 crores, the Corporation's share being Rs. 13.64 crores. The project is scheduled to be completed by May 1985.


Bombay-Manmad Product Pipeline: The project envisages installation of facilities for pipeline transportation of MS, SKO, HSD and LDO from Bombay to Manmad with an objective to minimise transportation costs, reduction in

product loss and energy consumption. Under Phase I, estimated to cost Rs. 42.82 crores, the throughput capacity will be 1.95 million MT per annum. This will be progressively raised to 4.17 million MT per annum at the end of Phase III of the project, with an estimated additional investment of Rs. 10.39 crores. The project completion for Phase I is planned within 33 months after getting the Government approval to whom the Feasibility Report has already been submitted.

PERSONNEL

Industrial Relations improved considerably during the year under review, after a period of much stress and strain in the previous year. Workmen in the Refinery, who had resorted to an illegal strike in mid-January 1982, returned to work on 18.6.1982, following the signing of a 4-year settlement with the Unions on 17.6.1982. Long Term Settlements were also signed with Unions in LTS Regions of Bombay, Calcutta and Madras (Tamil Nadu) of the Marketing Division on 30.4.1982. 31.1.1983 and 4.7.1983 respectively.

To take care of the large scale retirements of Management Staff in the next few years as also to provide for the growth of the Corporation, a massive recruitment programme has been initiated, and during the year 1982-83, 358 persons were inducted at various levels. Likewise, 726 clerical and labour employees were recruited during the same year.

For attracting good talent and to also provide for flexibility in transfer of staff for operational needs/career development, adequate housing accommodation, particularly in cities like Bombay, is essential. The Corporation's requirement of housing on an all-India basis has been assessed. During 1982-83, action was taken to purchase about 200 flats in Bombay. Flats were also acquired at other locations as necessary and some have also been built at the Refinery.

With a view to motivating the personnel of oil companies to strive for better performance, the Government has formulated Productivity Incentive Scheme effective 1st April, 1982. The Corporation has laid down the targets both for the Refining and Marketing activities for the year 1982-83 in relation to which the actual performance for the year will be evaluated for the purpose of payment of the productivity incentive.

Training and development of personnel continued to receive high priority. Besides imparting training at the Corporation's Training Centre and "on the job" training, employees were sent to outside training courses and seminars.

The total number of foreign tours undertaken by the officers during the year was 16 and the total expenditure incurred amounted to Rs. 997,676.

At the time of the take over in January 1976, out of a total of 4,806 employees (excluding sweepers), there were only 94 Scheduled Caste and 15 Scheduled Tribe employees, i.e. just about 2.3% in all. Since then, as a result of intensified efforts, out of a total increase of 2,106 in the number of employees (excluding sweepers) as on 31st March, 1983, those belonging to SC and ST numbered 496 and 170 i.e. 23.6% and 8.1% respectively. The position of these categories in the Corporation's employment as at 31st March, 1983 is as follows:

Represents shortfall in some States. However, on an all India basis, 185 SC candidates were recruited over and above the reserved vacancies.

Since, in the case of Management Staff the required percentage of reservation had not been achieved, exclusive recruitment for SC/ST candidates was conducted in November 1982 and February 1983 with relaxed standards, and 51 SC and 10 ST candidates were selected. Of these, 43 SC and all the 10 ST candidates have already joined so far. An advertisement was also issued in December 1982 exclusively for ST candidates to fill the vacancies of drivers, fitters, electricians, instrument mechanics, steno-typists and clerk-typists in the Refinery but the response was very poor.

With a view to assisting the SC/ST candidates to complete the Engineering Degree Courses/Technical trades, the Corporation has introduced two Schemes for award of Scholarships to SC and ST students/ trainees only.

Under the first scheme, SC/ST Under-Graduate Engineering students are eligible for 15 scholarships, the value of each of which is upto Rs. 400/- per month (since raised to Rs. 500/- per month). The scholarship is available for the entire duration of the Engineering Degree Course and upon successful completion of the studies, the scholars will be eligible for employment in the officer cadre of the Corporation. Under this scheme, introduced from the 1982-83 academic year, 9 scholarships—4 for Scheduled Castes and 5 for Scheduled Tribes — have been awarded. The balance six could not be awarded due to lack of response from the Institutes.

Under the second scheme applicable to SC/ST trainees at the Industrial Training Institutes, 18 scholarships of the value of Rs. 150/- per month each will be awarded to SC/ST candidates only. To begin with, six Industrial Training Institutes have been

selected in Maharashtra — three in Greater Bombay and one each in Thane, Ambarnath and Vangaon. Under this scheme also, the SC/ST candidates, on completion of their training, will be eligible for appointment as apprentices and later also for employment in the Refinery.

Yet another scheme is being introduced from 1983-84 for giving 25 merit scholarships of the value of Rs. 150/- per month each to children of SC/ST employees only tenable for a period upto 5 years for post S.S.C. studies (upto graduation level).

The Parliamentary Committee on the Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes visited the Corporation's Refinery at Bombay on 29th June, 1983 and had meeting with the representatives of the SC/ST employees and later with the Chairman & Managing Director and other officials of the Corporation.

Due to the absence of the Chief Vigilance Officer for over two years, this activity did not receive the desired attention. The Chief Vigilance Officer has since been appointed effective 10th December, 1982, and a thorough review of staff and other matters in the Vigilance Department has been carried out. After the required additional staff is in position, this Department will be able to function more effectively. During the period under report, the Vigilance Department made 17 enquiries and 27 inspections/surprise checks.

PARTICULARS OF EMPLOYEES

Particulars of employees, under section 217(2-A) of the Companies Act, 1956, read with the Companies (Particulars of Employees) Rules, 1975, are set out in Annexure I to this Report.

PROGRESSIVE USE OF HINDI

Efforts were continued for the progressive use of Hindi during the year under report. Apart from the Senior Hindi Officer at the Chairman's Office, 5 Hindi Officers were appointed during the year — one each at Bombay, Calcutta, Delhi and Madras and also at the Refinery. Additional posts of Hindi Typists/Clerks have been sanctioned which are being filled up.

The Memorandum & Articles of Association of the Corporation have been translated and printed in Hindi. Besides, 25 other documents have also been prepared in bilingual form. All containers & packages have also been printed in Hindi and English.

While Praveen and Pragya classes are held in the Chairman's Office at Bombay, Prabodh classes are held at the Refinery and the Area offices at Calcutta, Delhi and Madras and also at Installation office at Cochin. With a view to attracting large number of employees, cash prizes ranging from Rs. 300 to Rs. 500 are awarded for passing various Hindi examinations. Debate, Calligraphy and Essay competitions were organised and the successful candidates awarded prizes in cash and also given Hindi books.

During the year, 3 Hindi Workshops were conducted and the staff acquainted with the Official Language Act/Rules and given practical training to translate, write letters, drafts, etc. in Hindi.

SUBSIDIARY COMPANY

At present, the Corporation has only one subsidiary company, viz. Burmah-Shell Properties Private Limited. An application has been made to the Registrar of Companies, Bombay to strike the name of the Company off the Register under section 560 of the Companies Act, 1956.

DIRECTORS

Shri S. M. Patankar resigned from the Board with effect from 25th January, 1983. Directors place on record their appreciation of the valuable services rendered by him to the Corporation. Shri B. Swaminathan has been appointed as Director with effect from 17th June, 1983.

In terms of Article 77 of the Articles of Association of the Corporation, Shri R. Vasudevar and Shri B. Swaminathan will retire at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting.

AUDITORS

The present Auditors of the Corporation, M/s. Sorab S. Engineer & Co. and M/s. M. P. Chitale & Co. will retire at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting. Auditors for the year 1983-84 will be appointed by the Central Government under section 619(2) of the Companies Act. 1956.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Directors express their thanks for the guidance and support received from the Government of India and the various State Governments. The Directors also wish to place on record their appreciation of the sincere and devoted services rendered by the employees of the Corporation.

AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE SHAREHOLDERS

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of BHARAT PETROLEUM CORPORATION LIMITED, as at 31st March, 1983 and also the annexed Profit & Loss Account of the Corporation for the year ended on that date, and report that:

- We have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit.
- 2. In our opinion, proper books of account as required by law have been kept by the Corporation, so far as appears from our examination of those books.
- 3. The Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account dealt with by the report are in agreement with the books of account.
- 4. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said accounts subject to Note No. 1(a) regarding transactions relating to Pool Accounts, Note No. 3 regarding confirmations of balances due to/from other Oil Companies, Note No. 4 regarding adjustments of Inter Oil Companies transactions, Note No. 5 regarding crude oil costs, Note No. 9 regarding Managerial Remuneration being subject to approval of the Central Government, and read together with other Notes thereon, give the information required by the Companies Act, 1956 in the manner so required and give a true and fair view:
 - (i) In the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Corporation as at 31st March, 1983

and

- (ii) In the case of the Profit and Loss Account, of the Profit for the year ended on that date.
- 5. As required by the Manufacturing and Other Companies (Auditors' Report) Order, 1975 issued by the Central Government in terms of Section 227 (4A) of the Companies Act, 1956 and on the basis of such checks of the books and records as we considered appropriate and as per the information and explanations given to us in the course of audit and to the best of our knowledge and belief, we further report that:
 - (i) As regards the Marketing Division, the Corporation has maintained proper records showing full particulars, including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets except that details of fixed assets below Rs. 750/- of Plant and Machinery are listed in a separate memoranda. The Corporation follows a phased programme of two yearly cycle, as regards verification of the said assets. No serious discrepancies have been noticed on verification so done during the year.

As regards the Refining Division, this work is in progress. To the extent that physical verification of some of the fixed assets was carried out by the Management, we are informed that no significant discrepancies were noticed.

- (ii) None of the fixed assets of the Corporation have been revalued during the year.
- (iii) Physical verification has been conducted by the Management during the year in respect of finished goods, stores, spare parts and raw materials, other than those with third parties and in transit. In our opinion, the frequency of verification is reasonable. We are informed that no significant discrepancies have been noticed on such verification as compared to book records. In our opinion, the valuation of these stocks is fair and proper in accordance with the normally accepted accounting principles and is on the same basis as in the earlier year.

- (iv) The Corporation has not obtained any loans from Companies, firms or other parties listed in the registers maintained under Section 301 and Section 370 (1-C) of the Companies Act, 1956.
- (v) The Corporation has advanced a loan, repayable on demand, to a Government of India Undertaking which, after adjusting set offs on account of supplies of stores and materials, pursuant to agreed arrangements, amounted to Rs. 1,74,94,839. As the repayment of the Principal has not been made on demand, the rate of interest has been enhanced as provided by the terms and conditions. Interest on this loan is not received regularly. The Corporation has also given loans and advances to its employees who are by and large repaying the Principal with interest as stipulated.
- (vi) In our opinion, and according to the information and explanations given to us, there is an adequate internal control procedure commensurate with the size of the Corporation and the nature of its business for the purchase of stores, raw materials, plant and machinery and other assets.
- (vii) According to the information given to us, there are no purchases during the year of stores and raw materials exceeding Rs. 10,000 in value for each type thereof from the subsidiaries, firms, companies or other parties in which the Directors are interested as listed in the register maintained under Section 301 of the Companies Act, 1956.
- (viii) According to the information and explanations given to us, the Corporation has a procedure for determining damaged and unserviceable stores and raw materials. Provision for loss in respect thereof has been made in the accounts.
 - (ix) The Corporation has complied with the provisions of Section 58-A of the Companies Act, 1956, and the rules framed thereunder for deposits accepted from the public.
 - (x) In our opinion and as per the information and explanations given to us, reasonable records have been maintained by the Corporation for the sale and disposal of scrap. We are informed that the Corporation has no realisable by - products.
 - (xi) The Corporation has an adequate internal audit system which, in our opinion, is commensurate with the size and nature of its business.
- (xii) As per the information given to us, the maintenance of cost records has not been prescribed by the Central Government under Section 209 (1)(d) of the Companies Act, 1956 for the year under review for any of the products of the Corporation.
- (xiii) According to the records of the Corporation, Provident Fund dues have been regularly deposited during the year with the appropriate authorities.
- (xiv) In respect of the trading activities carried on by the Corporation, it has determined the damaged goods. As per the information given to us, the value of such goods is not significant.

1. (1) Fixed Assets, Schedule D Less Depreciation Rs. 75,53,47,194

Under-provision of depreciation for certain plant and machinery working two/three shifts in the Refinery and Marketing Divisions over the years, contrary to the provision of Section 205(2) read with Section 350 of the Companies Act has resulted in overstatement of profits in the current and previous years, which is not readily quantifiable in full. On some test-checked items alone, the under-provision of depreciation (and overstatement of profit) was Rs. 47.45 lakhs for 1982-83 and Rs. 130.76 lakhs (approximately) from 1978-79 to 1981-82.
